Letter from the President

Dear Fellow Members,

As your Board President, I am dedicated to honoring Clinton's history while committing to a presence in today's community. My hope is that philosophy will be reflected in our organization's participation in Village events as well as in hosting the Richard L. Williams' Speaker Series. Many of this year's presentations are topics suggested by our membership.

This coming year has promised to be an exciting time honoring our rich traditions and recognizing our ancestors. Of note, CHS has received a grant from the Town-Gown Fund to purchase a new sign for the Old Burying Ground. Additionally, this is the first grant made in memory of Andy Burns. A ceremony is planned for the unveiling of the new sign in Autumn 2023. Representatives of the Town-Gown Fund and members of the Burns family will be invited to this event as well as local community leaders, veteran's groups and the DAR.

Additionally, the Clinton Historical Society has submitted a Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI) proposal under the stewardship of CHS board member Joanne Gilles. This project proposal includes fencing surrounding the Old Burying Ground; entrance posts, a decorative arch reading "Old Burying Ground, Clinton 1788", wrought iron benches and landscaping.
